LUBRICANTS 101

Need to have gears running smoothly for long periods of time in a humid environment? There's a lubricant for that. Can't turn a corroded bolt? There's a lubricant for that, too.

Actually, **there are four different types of lubricants, each having certain features** to address the lubrication required for keeping machines running smoothly.

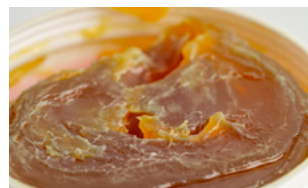


OIL: Lubricating oils are liquids which come in various weights (or viscosity). The lower the weight number, the thinner the oil. Multigrade oils have two numbers; the first indicating the viscosity when cold and the second when hot. Additives can be mixed with the oil to prevent oxidizing and corrosion.

Uses: Oils are good for lubricating something without the resistance that's common when using grease, such as hinges, bearings, and tool maintenance.

GREASE: Greases have a thick stickiness which helps them to adhere to surfaces. They are comprised of oil mixed with a thickener and sometimes have additional lubricating components.

Uses: Greases have the power to adhere to surfaces for long periods of time as they seal out dust particles and water droplets. Greases are great for lubricating machines which are not frequently used and aren't regularly lubricated, such as gears, chains, bearings and linkages.

PENETRATING LUBRICANT: These products are not meant for long-lasting lubrication. They are thin liquids/sprays and formulated to infiltrate tiny cracks in metal to add lubrication and break up rust.

Uses: Ideal for loosening stuck nuts or bolts and brief lubrication. They are also effective in removing adhesive stickers.

DRY LUBRICANT: Use a dry lubricant when you need lubrication that will work for an extended period of time under high pressure conditions.

USE: Dry lubricants keep metal parts free of dust or dirt and seal out water droplets. They are ideal for using on infrequently used machines when regular lubrication with oil can be easily overlooked, such as gears, chains and linkages.

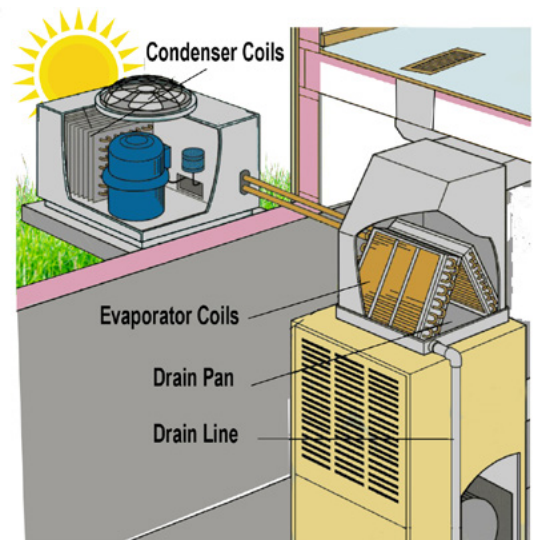
SPRING IS COIL CLEANING SEASON

Each spring before activating air conditioner units, **condenser coils should be cleaned and evaporator coils evaluated.** This is particularly important after experiencing extreme winter weather and even more significant if cleaning was not done last fall.

Outdoor condenser coils should be cleaned every six months as they can be contaminated with environmental factors such as dust, dirt, moisture, grass clippings, etc.

Indoor evaporator coils, although encased in protective shells, should be inspected every six months for signs of dust or debris. Even a fine layer of dust on evaporator coils can interfere with functioning. Cleaning should be done based on contamination and can range from every six months to four years.

Since acid-based coil cleaners can be quite hazardous and need to be used with great caution, QuestSpecialty offers an expansive line of alkaline-based coil cleaners in both foaming and non-foaming formulations. Experts advise using heavy foaming cleaners on outdoor condenser coils, as they can create quite a mess during use.
