4420 DYNAMO Wasp & Hornet Killer


Kills wasps, hornets, yellow jackets and bees on contact. Provides residual action as wasps and hornets return to nest.

SAFETY ASPECTS OF USING SURE SHOT EXTENDED SPRAYS



In 2023, 500,000 were treated for injuries from ladder accidents; 300 were fatal. *(American Academy of Orthopedic Surgeons)*

Ladder safety is third most common OSHA violation. *(OSHA)*

Estimated cost of ladder injuries in US is \$24 billion including work loss, medical, legal, liability and pain & suffering expenses. *(CDC)*



Dirty windshields can reduce visibility up to 40%.

In some states, you can be liable for an accident if you can not clearly see through your windshield.

Standing on tires to clean windshields is in violation of OSHA 29 CFR 1910.23 - Walking-Working Surfaces as tires are not considered a stable work surface. Tires are curved, dirty and often wet or oily.



Wasps nest in electrical boxes due to the warmth and vibration, favoring meter covers, switch boxes or outdoor break panels. It is important to use a dielectric formulation in these areas.

Outdoor workers surprised by wasps, hornets or yellow jackets can fall from ladders or platforms.
